Smoke free Bingo has been a success. Attendance and revenue have increased. I was concerned revenue and attendance would fall






There **ARE** Catholic men in our parishes, neighborhoods and workplaces who **WOULD** be interested in joining the Knights of Columbus if they were only invited.
