Tinsley Passes Gavel To Heffernan

At the general membership meeting on June 9th election of officers for 2009-2010 was conducted and Grand Knight Dan Tinsley passed the gavel to Brother Knight Jim Heffernan. In doing so, Tinsley completed his third consecutive term as Grand Knight and became only the second member in the history of our council to serve more than two consecutive terms as the top officer.

Throughout his tenure as GK Dan has continuously looked for opportunities to improve our council and never backed away from a problem that needed to be addressed. When a suggestion was made for easier-to-understand financial reports, Dan came through and provided a monthly accounting of how we were doing, our bottom line projections for the remainder of the year, and any corrective actions that we needed to take.

When the subject of converting our hall to a non-smoking facility was raised, it would have been easy to “dodge the bullet” and put it off for the next Grand Knight. The potential impact to our bingo operation was real and one that could not be ignored. Despite the risk however, and the negative comments that were sure to come, Dan knew that it was the right thing to do. He led us through the change and we owe him a debt of gratitude for his courage.

More recently, Dan has worked with a small delegation that has visited other bingo operations looking for ideas to improve our own program. He has tirelessly examined alternatives and is working with our bingo ream captains to prepare for changes that will hopefully improve our attendance and profit.


