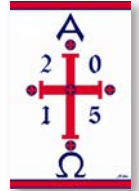

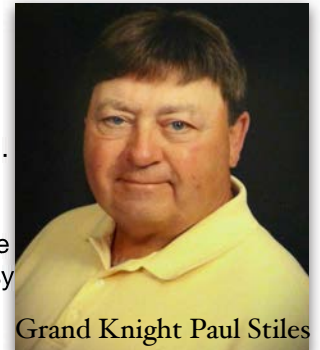

By tradition, the Catholic Church dedicates April to the Blessed Sacrament. Frequent prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, reserved in the tabernacle, is a path to spiritual growth. When we come before the Blessed Sacrament, it's all too easy to be distracted, to let our minds wander to our cares and responsibilities. In this prayer for the peace of Christ, composed by John Henry Cardinal Newman, we ask Christ in the Holy Eucharist to purify our hearts so that we may be filled with His love.
