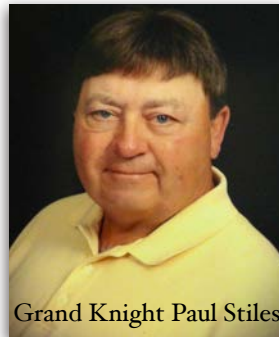

The donation was in response to a grant application that I submitted and the dollars will go towards the development of a Life Skills Room in the special education depart at BNL High School. 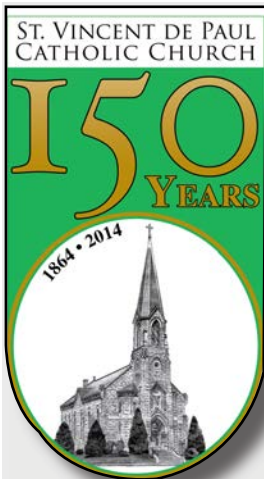
