Brother Knights,

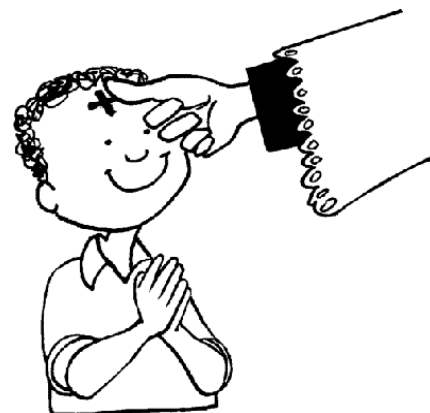

The Deacon Corner

In February, the Catholic Church celebrates the Holy Family—Jesus, Mary, and Joseph.
