Our Hall has been painted, electrical has been updated, new blinds installed, ceiling in the assembly area has been restored, and the bingo machine has been

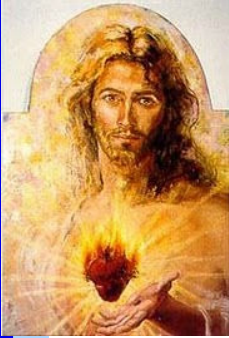

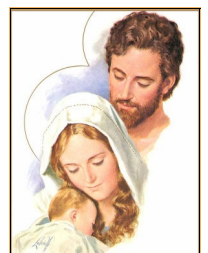
June Family of the Month
