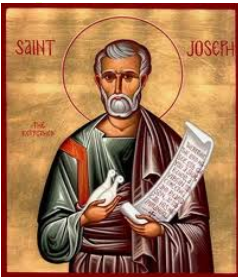
Primary business to be brought fourth includes: The election of two members to the board and any other matter brought to the attention of the Board of Directors and the membership, will be addressed.
