Communications are key

to success in most things; we are no exception. One of the improvement themes from our SWOT action session on February 28th was to improve communications, specifically getting our message out, and to be creative in doing so. Specific discussion centered on utilization of social media, local news media, advertising, and integration with Parish information. I would like to discuss some of our advances in this area as well as what you are reading this moment – our newsletter.

Integration of KofC and Parish Information. Brother John Marshek took an action to work on this and did a great job immediately. He utilized whatever scheduled events he could accumulate and then broadened the integration tool he had already created for the Catholic Community of Lawrence County. He was then able to overlay our events on all of the Parish events to find any overlaps. It was quickly detected that John needed a more comprehensive KofCI 166 Calendar that was more accurate than what he was using, and once that is satisfied, our calendar will be fully integrated with our Parish.

KofCI 166 Program Event Calendar. We had a semblance of this but had not been disciplined about maintaining it. Accepting the risk of sharing a work in progress, our Program Event Calendar summary is attached later in this newsletter – please use it to plan how you can join in any of these events. Please review it and if you have any additions, subtractions, comments or otherwise, please let me know. It is a great guide for what we are planning for the year though, and I would encourage you to look for those events that you will be involved in this year. This is the information that John Marshek will be integrating with the Parish.

News Media. We are still working on this, but I hope everyone has noticed how often we are showing up in the Times-Mail newspaper. We have been posting pictures from various events (Tootsie Roll, Coats for Kids, Free Throw Contest, etc.). If someone has any recommendations or is interested in creating improvements in this area, we will gladly accept the assistance.

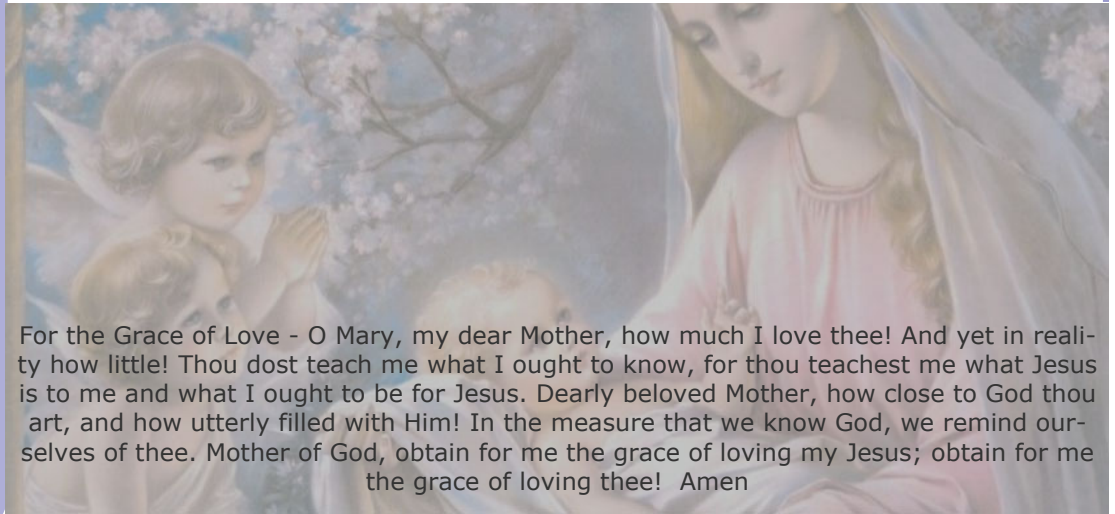
