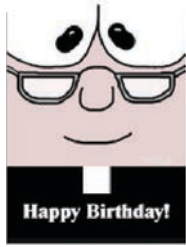
we held yet another record breaking Tootsie Roll Drive, raising over \$20,000 dollars.

The Holy Rosary

The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary. Our Lady of the Rosary is credited with victory in a number of the battles that those feasts celebrate. Chief among these is the Battle of Lepanto (October 7, 1571), in which a Christian fleet defeated a superior Ottoman Muslim fleet and stopped the westward expansion of Islam in the Mediterranean. In honor of the victory, Pope Pius V instituted the Feast of Our Lady of Victory, which is still celebrated as the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7). The best way to celebrate the Month of the Holy Rosary is, of course, to pray the rosary daily. Another prayer is the theologically rich prayer to Mary, the Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, which calls to mind our Blessed Mother's protection of the Church. ~*Deacon Dave Reising*
