As fall begins our Catholic liturgical year draws to a close at the beginning of Advent. In the traditional Catholic calendar, many of the feasts between mid-September and the first Sunday in Advent make reference to conflicts between Christianity and Islam, and great victories in battles in which the Church was threatened. These encounters should turn our thoughts to the end times, when the Church will undergo trials and tribulations before the return of Christ the King. We need to remember that Our Lady of the Rosary is credited with victory in a number of the battles. The best way to celebrate the Month of the Holy Rosary is, of course, to pray the rosary daily especially as a family. In the prayer below to Our Lady of the Rosary, we ask the Virgin Mary to help us to cultivate a habit of interior prayer through the daily recitation of the rosary.

O Virgin Mary, grant that my praying the Rosary may be for me each day, in the midst of my manifold duties, a bond of unity in my actions, a tribute of piety, a sweet refreshment, an encouragement to walk joyfully along the path of duty.
