Worthy Supreme Knight and Brother Carl,

With this letter, I am submitting my resignation/retirement from the office of Financial Secretary, of Council 1166, Bedford, Indiana, effective, July 28, 2017.

It is with mixed feelings that I am doing so. As of July 27, 2017, I will have served in this office for 45 consecutive years. I love the job of Financial Secretary and will miss it dearly. I am proud to have served with 32 grand knights in our council, assisting them in that demanding job of making our Bedford Council 1166 one of the most active councils in the state of Indiana.

As a matter of record, my other accomplishments in the past 45 years, after serving as Grand Knight of Council 1166, 1971 to 1972, are as follows:

Initiated into the Fourth Degree in Alexandria, Louisiana, on April 23, 1961. The exemplification was held in honor of Bishop Charles P. Grecco, Bishop of Alexandria. I was an active duty member of the U.S. Air Force at that time.

One of the founding members of our Fourth Degree Assembly 1921, and was elected to serve as its first Faithful Navigator.

Appointed Faithful Marshal, of the Indiana District and served with Master, John Holloran, for four years.

Appointed District Deputy, by State Deputy, Joseph Kruyer and State Deputy, Richard Scheiber, serving a total of four years.

Appointed State Community Director by State Deputy, Francis Gallagher, serving two years.

Elected State Warden, serving with State Deputy, Robert Lynch, for two years.

Elected to the Gibault Children's Services Board of Trustees, serving as a trustee for twenty two years. I am currently serving as a trustee emeritus.

A founding member of the Lawrence County Problem Pregnancy Center Board of Directors, serving as the first president of the board.

I have always believed my duties of office while serving as Financial Secretary should never preclude me from involvement in other civic and Knights of Columbus activities.

On the other hand, while I am pushing the ripe old age of eighty, it is necessary, in my opinion, that I should step aside, while I am still in relative good health, both mentally and physically. And to be able to serve as mentor for my replacement, Daniel W. Tinsley. 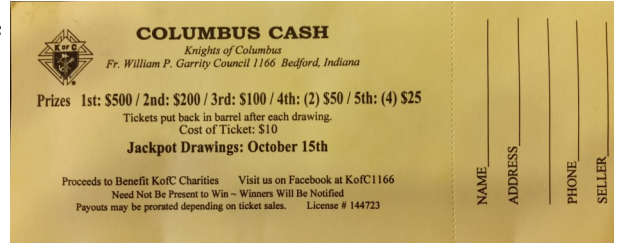

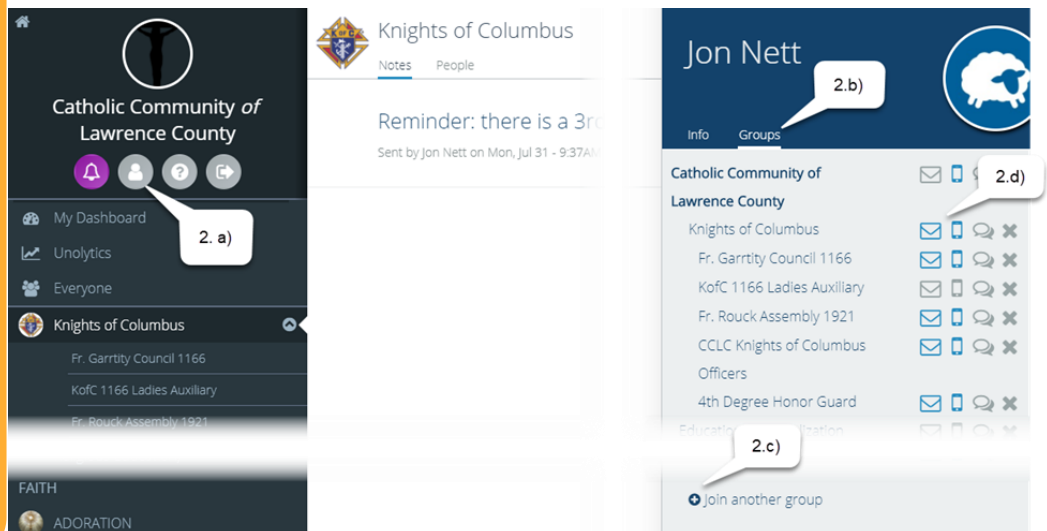


FLOCK NOTES

Want to keep in touch better? Council 1166 is on FlockNote! There is a subgroup for the 3rd degree, the 4th degree, the color guard, and the officers. There is even a subgroup for the Ladies Auxiliary, too! How to join:

- 1a) If you have not already joined the CCLC Flocknote, go to <https://www.flocknote.com/cclc> and follow the prompts to join. You can select the K of C subgroups as you join.
 - 1b) If you are already on Flocknote for CCLC, go to <https://www.flocknote.com/login>. If you have not been to the website before, or you forgot your password, follow the prompt to reset or create a password.
 2. Select the groups you want to join:
 - a) Click the "My Info" icon.
 - b) In the "My Info" window, click "Groups".
 - c) Select the groups you want to join by clicking "Join another group" link.
 - d) Once the group is in your list, click the cell phone icon for text or the envelop icon for email. If the icon is blue, you will receive that type of item from that group.

The Deacon Corner

The Catholic Church traditionally dedicates the month of September to Our Lady of Sorrows. The reason is because the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows falls on September 15. Like many of the lesser-known Marian feasts, the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows is tied to an event in the life of her Son Jesus. On September 14, we celebrate the feast of the Triumph of the Cross, which commemorates Christ's victory over death. But the next day, the 15th we remember the suffering of Mary as she stood at the foot of the Cross and witnessed the torture and death of her Son. We should remember the words of Simeon's to Mary at the Presentation of the Lord—that a sword would pierce her soul (Luke 2:34-35).



Through prayers we can unite ourselves to Mary in her sorrow, in the hope that we will one day also share her joy in the triumph of her Son. In particular, the pray "Mother of Sorrows" below, asks Mary to pray for us, so that we may look forward to the joy that comes from remaining faithful witnesses to Christ.
